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## Camper Packing List:

It is important that campers are packed properly and not to over pack or under pack for camp. If campers are packing themselves, please verify that they have packed properly. Please supply your camper with proper clothing including an outfit for 5 days plus 2 extra outfits, shoes, personal hygiene items, diapers/undergarments for the week. If camper has day or nighttime wetting issues, please add additional undergarments or clothing as necessary. **Each item must be marked with a “Sharpie” or laundry marker with the camper’s initials or name. Luggage must be labeled as well.** Camper Clothing labels can be purchased through the CampInTouch portal if you would like.

All items brought to camp should be able to fit into bag(s).

- 7 complete outfits (1 per day plus 2 extra) (shorts, shirts, socks, underwear, bras)
- Diapers or Pull-ups if applicable
- 2-3 pairs of pajamas
- 1 pair of jeans
- 1 jacket or sweatshirt, and/or rain gear
- Swimsuit or swimming trunks, water approved swimming diapers if applicable
- Closed Toe Walking Shoes. Flip Flops may only be worn in shower.
- Toothbrush, Toothpaste
- Shower items: Shampoo, Soap, etc
- Deodorant
- Hairbrush or comb
- Electric Razor (if you would like your camper shaved)
- Comfort item if needed (stuff animal or toy) Please limit comfort items to 2.
- Sleep machines, talk machines, or other required equipment, ie camper specific feeding items.
- Medication
  
- For campers who are doing the extended stay weekend, please pack a separate smaller bag for the weekend only. Friday night pajama’s through Sunday day clothes.

Linens are provided (swimming towels, bath towels, washcloths, bibs, and all bedding). Please do not pack these as they easily get lost within camp’s supply.

Camper should not bring the following: food, drinks, electronics, cell phones, camera, or money. If these items are brought, the staff is required to place them in the office. Camp New Hope, Inc. is not responsible for the loss of any such valuables.
